The Service Member & Family Support Program provides financial assistance and tailored support to help with the expenses incurred during initial hospitalization and throughout recovery.

- Bedside financial support
- Housing modifications
- Specialized equipment
- Adaptive transportation
- Home care nursing visits
- Caregiver support and retreats.

<u>The Transition Program</u> helps recipients thrive on their journey from recovery to reconnection.

- Educational support and career assistance provides them the skills to successfully build new, productive lives.
- The Apprenticeship Program helps veterans find a new passion, direction, and purpose. The Semper Fi Team inspires, motivates, and helps recipients find their new path forward through powerful mentor relationships.
- Veteran Leads provide a one-on-one mentorship experience for service members who transition out of the military and return to their local communities, often feeling lonely and fearful.





<u>The Integrative Wellness Program</u> applies a holistic approach to long-term health by providing tools to improve body, mind, and spirit, fostering healing through powerful therapies and innovative technologies.

- The Fund's Neuro-Fitness courses are uniquely designed to rebalance the brain and improve cognitive performance.
- The Tim & Sandy Day Canine Companions Program is dedicated to the training and expenses of providing service and companion dogs for fund recipients and their families.





Grape Stomper Semper Fi Benefit Dance – July 19, 2025

COMPELLING REASONS TO SUPPORT THE SEMPER FI AND AMERICA'S FUND

- This charity cares for our Nation's critically wounded, ill, and injured service members, veterans, and military families from all branches of the Armed Forces.
- It provides programs and services through a "needs-based" approach. Staff and volunteers work one-on-one with recipients and provide ongoing support for as long as legitimately needed.
- It has an A+ rating (100%) from Charity Watch and a 4-star rating for 15 years from Charity Navigator.
- When the Board voted to sponsor a Semper Fi Benefit Dance in 2016, 94% of all funds raised were used for their programs. Even with increased costs in recent years, it's still an impressive 90%.
- Their cost to raise \$100 is only \$4.
- Karen Guenther, the founder (2003/2004) and president since inception, received a salary of \$278K last year compared to the City of Hope president receiving 4.5 million and the Heart Association president 4.4 million.

A Holiday Hero - The Tenacity and Grit of Marine Corporal Jesse Medina



After Marine Corporal Jesse Medina was catastrophically injured in Afghanistan, he persisted, persevered, and was determined to get back into a service line of work. Today, he serves his community as a patrol supervisor with the police department.

On Christmas Day in 2011, while many gathered to celebrate the joy of the holidays with family and friends, Jesse was fighting for his life. His world changed in an instant when an IED blast took his right leg above the knee and resulted in his finger amputation, elbow damage, and multiple shrapnel wounds. Facing months of surgeries and a long and arduous road to recovery, Jesse naturally had doubts, tough new realities to consider, and difficult decisions to make about his future. But he would never have to travel the journey to healing on his own. "From the day I arrived at the hospital, The Fund was there, ready to assist."

Determined that Jesse would not spend the holidays alone, The Fund brought his family to his hospital bedside to offer care and support as he learned to navigate life as an amputee. In the early days of his injury, The Fund helped anticipate Jesse's needs and was there to provide a handicap van to transport him to and from appointments and to provide critical loss of income reimbursement for family members to remain by his side. Throughout the years, The Fund has remained faithful with grants for Jesse's own adaptive vehicle, specialized athletic equipment, and camaraderie, connection and ongoing support through Team Semper Fi,



PLANING AHEAD

GS Campout at Dos Picos County Park 17953 Dos Picos Park Road, Ramona, CA Only 50 miles from Temecula

- Dos Picos means two peaks and refers to the tall mountains in the background
- Very scenic with ancient oak groves featuring Coast Live Oaks, some endangered Engelmann Oaks, along with boulder-strewn mountain slopes
- Attractive Luelf Pond has wildlife and fish
- Nearby lake for fishing, too.
- Hiking trails, picnic tables, and horseshoe pits
- Covered pavilion for potluck dinner and dancing
- 52 RV campsites with partial hookups and many have a variety of shade trees (top photo)
- Six heated (no A/C) cabins with one double bed and three bunk beds. All the 200 sq. ft. cabins have a bathroom with toilet and sink (see photo of cabin one below), but only C3 - C6 have a shower. However, there are hot coinoperated showers nearby
- Similar to Potrero Park, where we camped last year, but considerably larger
- The only negative I heard last year was the distance to Potrero. Good news ..., Dos Picos is only 50 miles from Temecula!
